It was wonderful to see the power of using our talents and our desire to help our community which resulted in £320 for Julia's House.

Dressed in costumes, the children became their own author of Tail Tales and also played guess the book character by looking at clues left in our Hive area. Our events in the day were followed by our first Pyjamarama event which not only inspired the children as readers but provided us with another fundraising event. During the evening, the children read with their friends snuggled up with toys, blankets and torches as well as a visit to the craft rooms to make origami animals and potato characters based on well-loved children's books. As we enter the season of Lent, we have been looking at the meaning of Shrove Tuesday. Last week, we looked at the origin of the word Shrove/Shrive meaning to confess to our mistakes. We retold the parable of The Lost Son from the book of Luke and reflected on how his mistake was forgiven by his father. We thought about our own mistakes and how we can put things right.

We also had great fun this week in worship flipping pancakes (it is much harder than it looks!). On Shrove Tuesday it is tradition to use up all the luxury ingredients ready to make a sacrifice for Lent. We thought about how we can sacrifice our time during Lent to do good deeds at home. Children had

ideas such as making their beds, helping to cook meals and playing games with their siblings.

Our Friday Gamechangers worship is a celebration of children and people in our community who are making a difference. Last week, we celebrated one child for their progress in swimming; they are demonstrating resilience and aspiration by beating their personal best each lesson. Another child has been learning origami, making animals and objects. Their passion gave us the idea to include this at our Pyjamarama so that more children could learn this skill.



Looking after our environment is a regular theme and topic for discussion in our school curriculum and in our Gamechangers worship. It was wonderful to have our year 4 litter pickers back reminding us how we can make a difference in our own community. GLOBAL NEIGHBOURS



I am delighted to announce that Priory School has been awarded the Global Neighbours Bronze Award. Christian Aid's Global Neighbours programme celebrates schools which are helping pupils learn about global poverty and the Christian responsibility to tackle it, as well as giving them the tools to play a confident part in creating a fairer world. The Priory Church of England Priory has achieved Bronze Award status in recognition of its initiatives to encourage children to think of others throughout the world. Examples of our Global Citizenship at Priory School are as follows:

- celebrating diversity and promoting inclusivity and respect through PSHE lessons,
- exploring topics such as racism and cultural differences,
- learning about various religions, customs, and the challenges others face,
- reflecting on environmental issues through Science, Art, and project weeks, sharing their work with peers and parent,
- making changes to school practices to improve sustainability,
- collective worship encourages reflection on global issues like poverty and climate justice,
- involved in community service and are celebrated as "Game Changers",
- collaborating with charities and local businesses, with pupils organizing collections for global communities,
- supporting and collecting for food banks and raising funds for Ukrainian refugees.

I would like to give a special thanks to Miss Ross and Miss Field who have been leading this project for the last 18 months following on from the great work that Miss Webber started in 2022-2023. They have worked with the staff team and children to help evidence our journey and ensure all our pupils are given the opportunity to become courageous advocates, learning about and helping a range of causes in our local and global communities.
