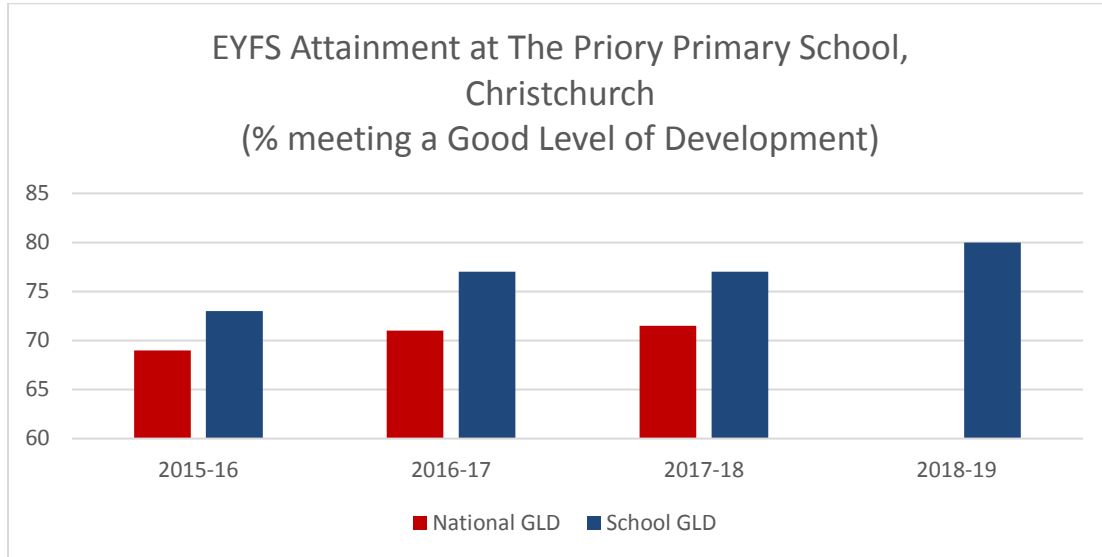




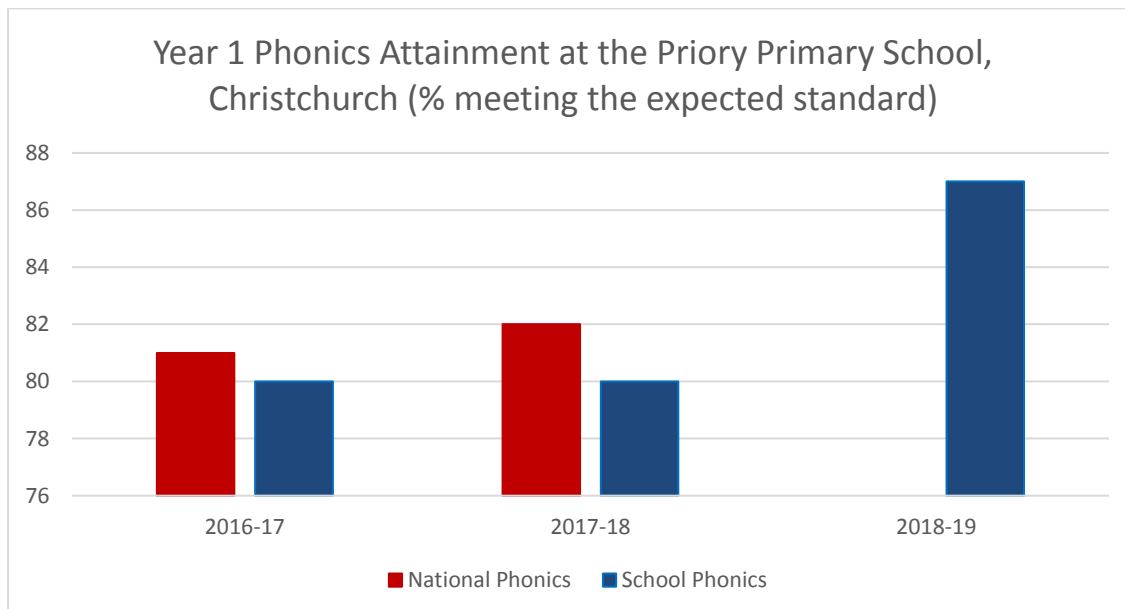
Summary of Results 2018-19

80% of Year R achieved a good level of development in their EYFS profile. Last year the national average was 71.5%.

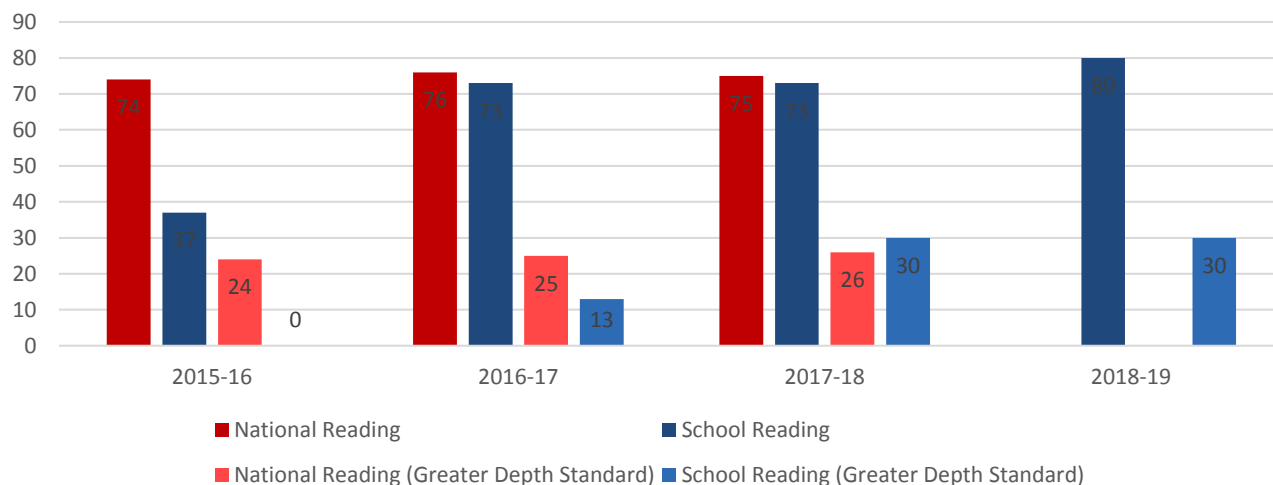
Y1 Phonics



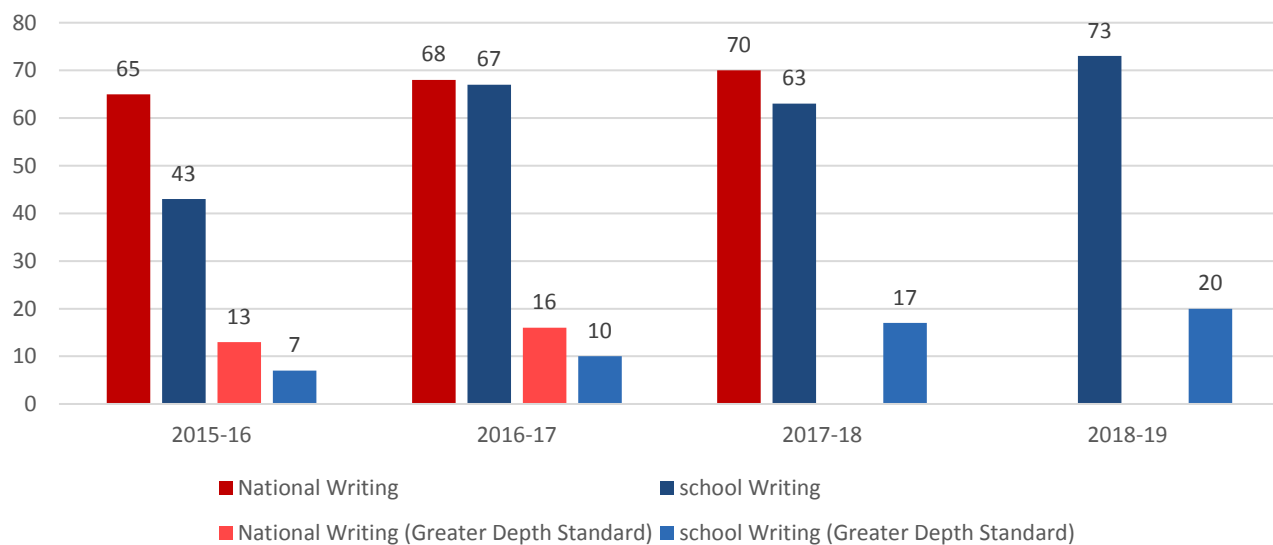
87% of Year 1 passed the Phonics assessment. Last year the national average was 82%.

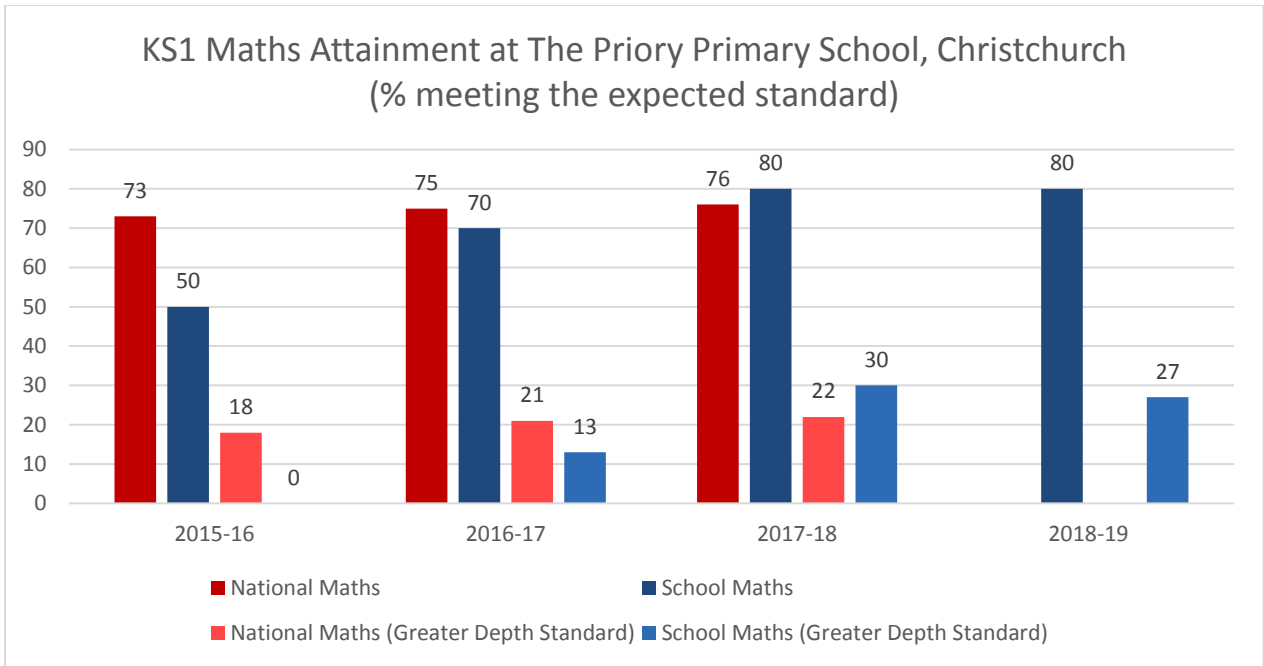
KS1 Assessment (Y2)

KS1 Reading Attainment at The Priory Primary School (% meeting the expected standard)

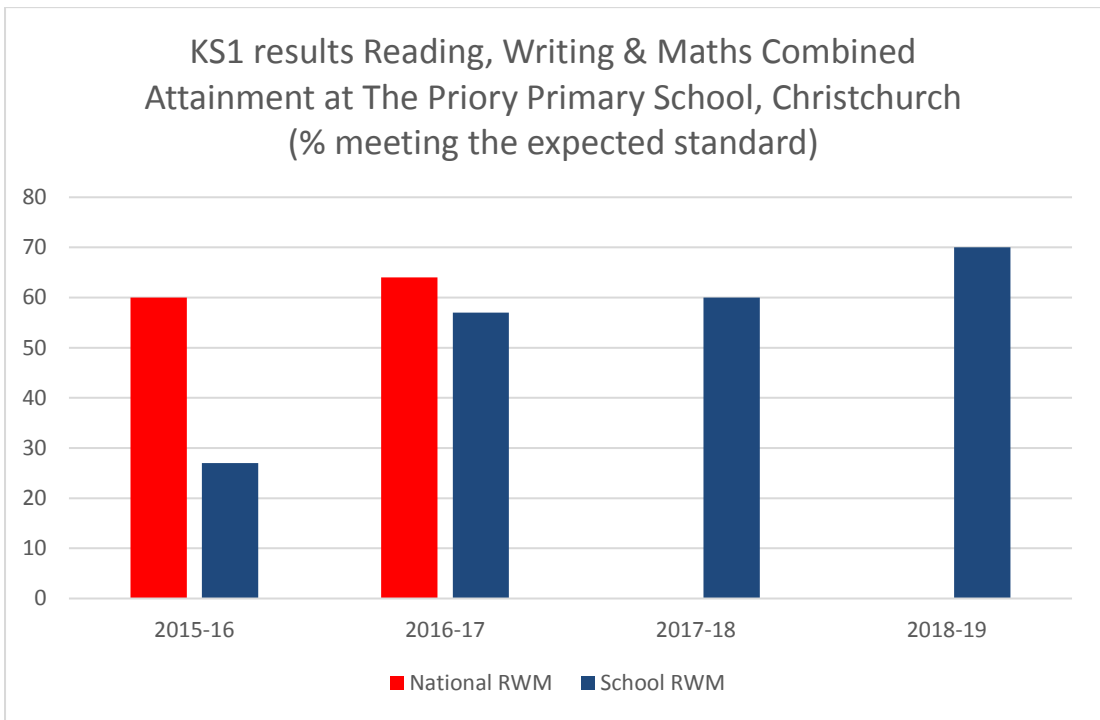


KS1 Writing Attainment at The Priory Primary School, Christchurch (% meeting the expected standard)





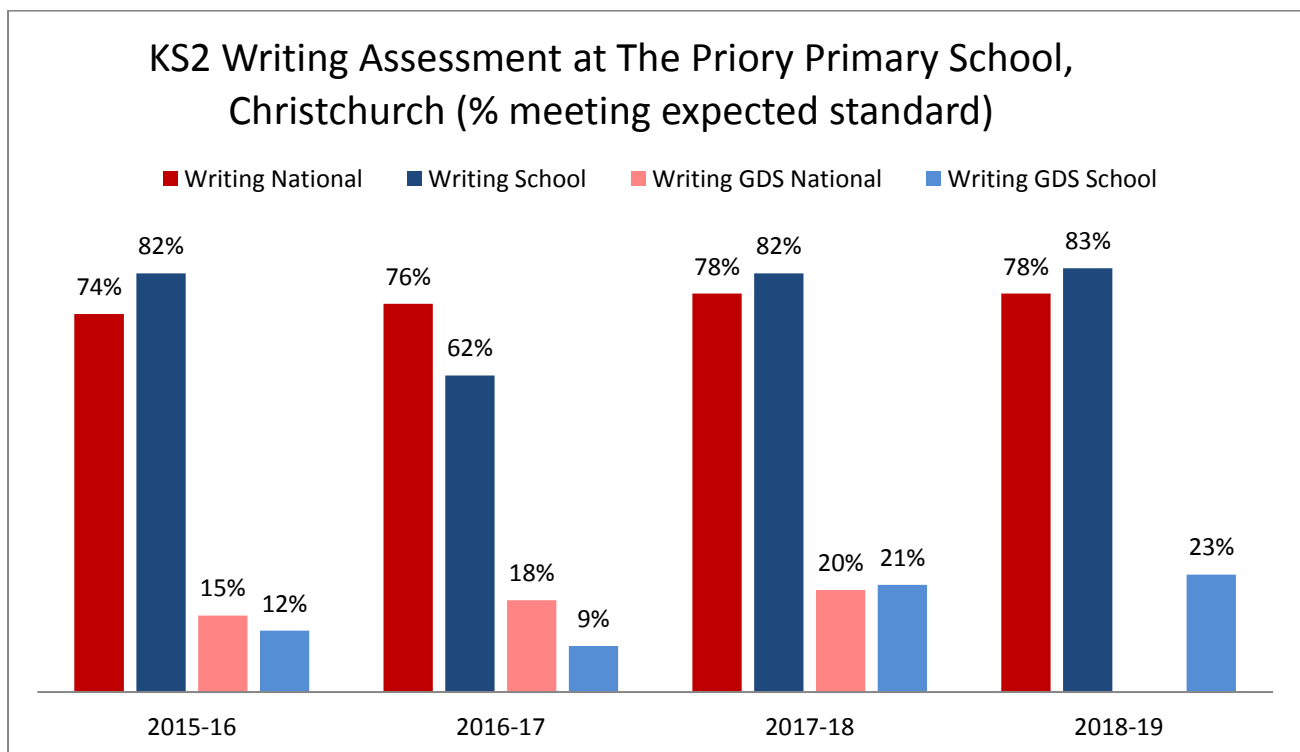
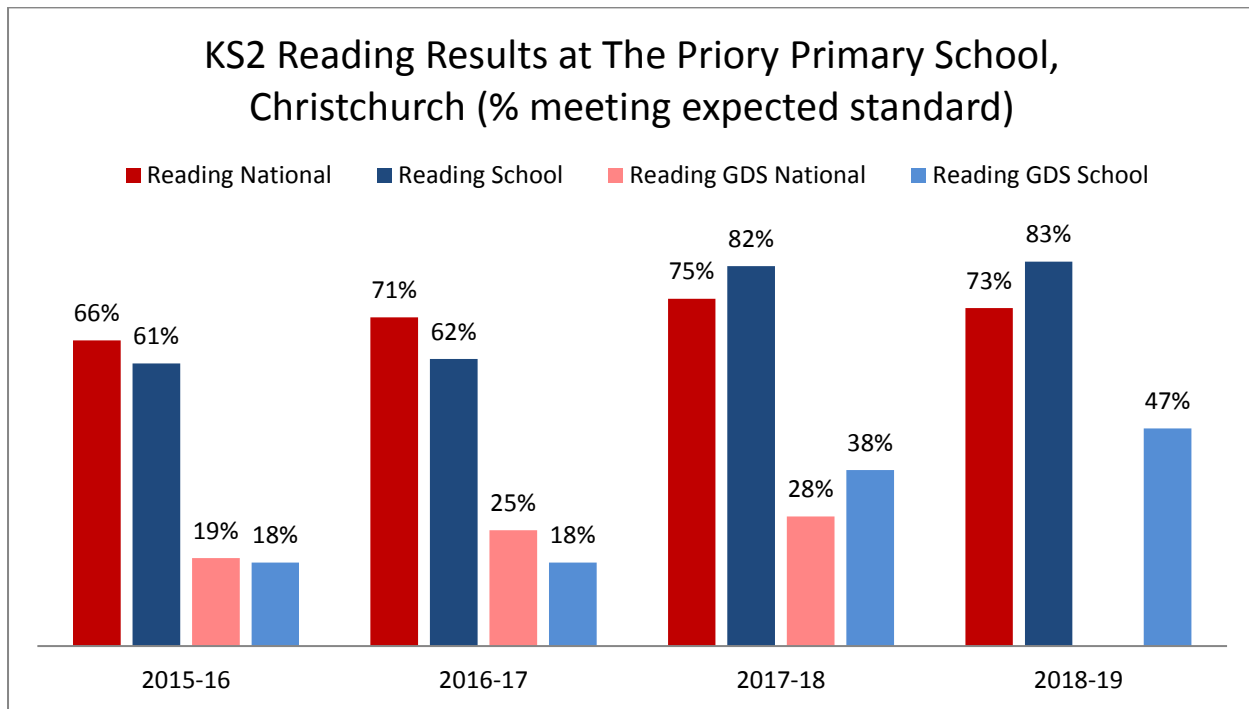
KS1 Combined Results



Our RWM (combined) score has been improving steadily over the last 3 years.

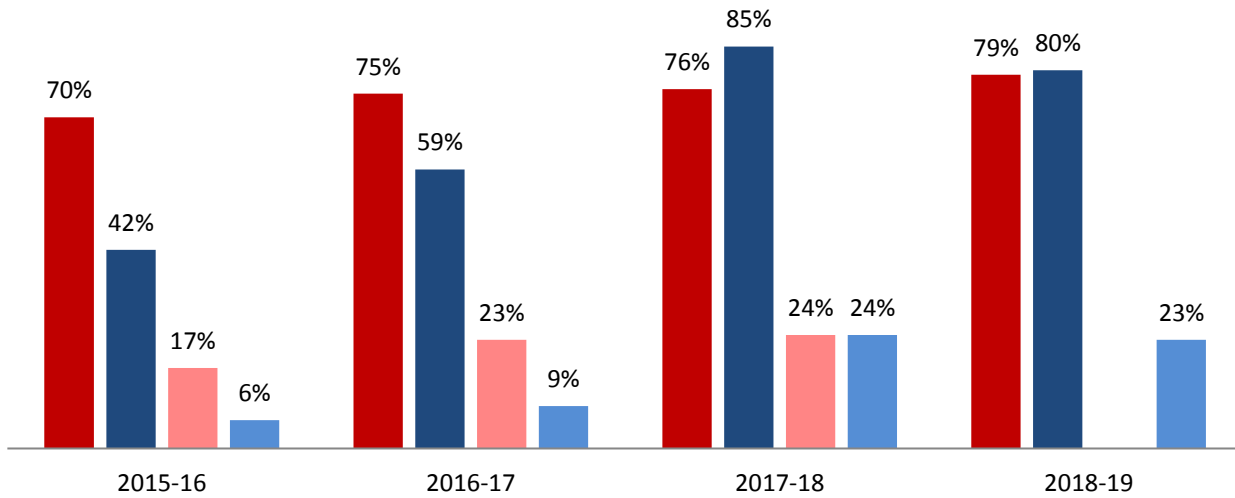
70% of Year 2 pupils achieved age-related in all 3 areas (R,W & M). There is no recent national comparison figure for this – the latest in 2016 was 64%.

KS2 Maths Results at The Priory Primary School, Christchurch (% meeting expected standard)

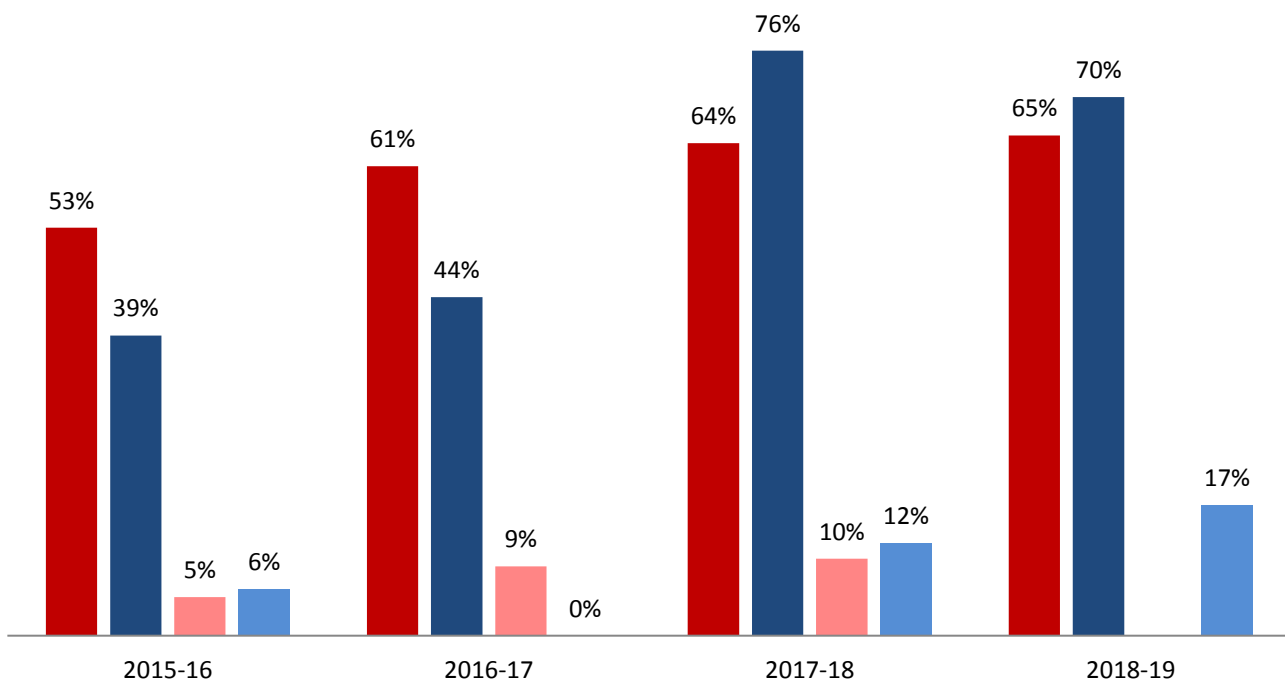
■ Maths National ■ Maths School ■ Maths GDS National ■ Maths GDS School

■ RWM National ■ RWM School ■ RWM GDS National ■ RWM GDS School

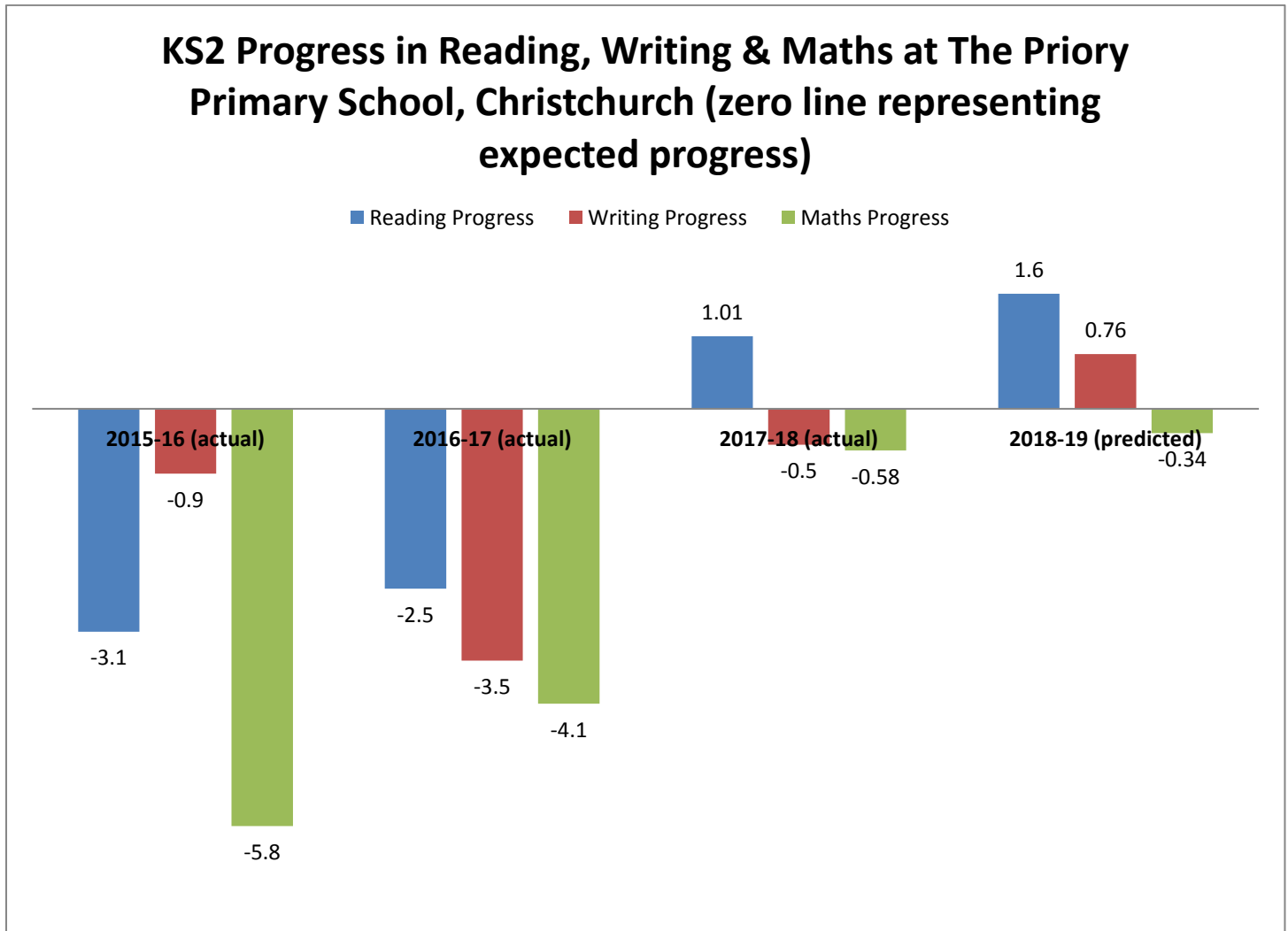


Our combined reading, writing and maths score is down on last year, but it is still above the national average. **70%** of Year 6 pupils achieved age-related in all 3 areas (R,W & M). The national comparison figure for this is 65% .

KS2 Progress Measure

The progress measure from Year 2 to Year 6 is increasingly the most important measure from an 'Ofsted' perspective, because it indicates the effectiveness of the school in providing a good level of education.

We are pleased to share these provisional results of our progress scores, which again reflect an improving picture. These scores represents progress that is in line with national expectations based on starting points – a requirement of our last Ofsted report.



Summary Headlines

All our key data is above the national average and our progress measures have improved.

Overall, our results indicate that we continue to be **a rapidly improving school**. It is the school's view that these indicate outcomes for children are now **GOOD**.
